PEG (Public Education Grant) Transfer

This application is to be completed by a parent/guardian of any student requesting a transfer under the Public Education Grant (PEG) program. The application must be completed and submitted to the campus principal. Final approval will be granted by the appropriate Executive Director of Elementary Education or Secondary Education. Check the appropriate box below for the type of transfer you are applying.

- PEG Interdistrict Transfer – A parent of a student enrolled in any of the campuses listed may make an application for their child to attend a campus in any other **school district** for the 2015-2016 school year. A school district chosen by a student’s parent under this statute is entitled to accept or reject the application for the student to attend school in that district. The district may not use criteria that discriminates on the basis of a student’s race, ethnicity, academic achievement, athletic abilities, language proficiency, sex, or socioeconomic status. Alternatively, a district may accept interdistrict transfers under Section 25.036 of the Texas Education Code.

- PEG Intradistrict Transfer – A parent of a student enrolled in any **NISD campus** listed may apply for their child to attend any open campus in the Northwest School District for the 2015-2016 school year.

This request is made with the full understanding of and agreement to the following:

1. Transportation is to be provided by the parent/guardian to the student of the approved transfer.
2. A student will not be eligible to transfer to a campus that has been closed by the Board of Trustees for student enrollment nearing or reaching the capacity of the school building.
3. A transfer will be revoked if a student completes all grades on the campus upon which the eligibility was originally based. (i.e. A student completes the 5th grade. The student must go to his/her attendance zoned middle school.)
4. The student is to return to his/her attendance zoned school, if the attendance zoned school is removed from the list of PEG schools.
5. A student who establishes residency in another attendance zone and that school is not on the PEG list, will no longer be eligible to attend the school which the student transferred.

6. If the district rezones an attendance boundary to where the student would no longer be zoned to attend the PEG identified school; the student is no longer eligible to attend the school which the student transferred.
